With the aim to cover part of syllabus and give students knowledge about construction projects, Civil Engineering Department of JEC has conducted a One day technical talk for UG 5th semester students in the departmental seminar hall on 1st November, 2018.

The program was inaugurated by Prof. P.K. Khaund, HOD, CED with an inaugural speech followed by greeting and welcoming of the resource person Ms. Swagata Baruah, SEC(QC) from Oil India Limited.

Ms. Swagata Baruah in her lecture elaborated different aspects of RCC building construction project. Ms. Baruah presented photographs and shared her in field experience with the students step by step right from foundation to final finishing of the project.

In the syllabus of 5th semester students learn about design of RCC structural elements in the subject RCC Design-I. But students generally feel the lack of in field exposure of a real time construction project.
