

BOYS' HOSTEL NO. 11

Boys' Hostel No. 11 is exclusively meant for **First-Year Boys' students of Jorhat Engineering College (JEC)**. Staying in the hostel is **mandatory for all First-Year Boys' students**, as per the rules of the College.

Accommodation

- **Total Capacity:** 200 students
- **Occupancy:** 3 boarders per room

Hostel Admission Fee Structure

The total amount payable at the time of College admission is **₹16,000/-**, as detailed below:

Particulars	Amount
One-time Establishment Fee	₹10,000/-
Refundable Security Deposit	₹3,000/-
Mess Dues for the Current Month	₹3,000/-
Total Admission Fee	₹16,000/-

Note:

- The **Establishment Fee of ₹10,000/-** is payable **only once** at the time of admission and is **non-refundable**.
- The **Security Deposit of ₹3,000/-** is **refundable**, subject to applicable hostel rules and adjustment of any outstanding dues or damages, if any.
- After admission, boarders will have to pay **only the monthly mess dues**.
- Monthly mess dues may generally vary from **₹2,000/- to ₹3,000/-**, depending on the actual mess expenditure for the month.

Hostel Facilities

The hostel provides:

- **24-hour water supply**
- **Uninterrupted Electricity supply**
- **100 Mbps internet facility**
- **Security facility**
- Furnished rooms with individual beds, study tables and storage cabinets
- Dining facility
- Indoor and outdoor gaming facilities

Items to be Arranged by the Boarders

Students are required to bring/arrange the following personal items for their stay in the hostel:

- Mattress
- Bed sheets
- Pillow
- Mosquito net
- Bucket
- Personal toiletries and other daily-use items as required

Dining Schedule

Dinner	From 8:00 PM

Boarders are expected to follow the prescribed dining schedule and maintain proper discipline in the dining hall.

Games & Recreation

The hostel provides facilities for indoor and outdoor games, including:

- Football
- Badminton

These facilities are intended to promote physical activity, recreation and healthy interaction among the boarders.

Hostel Administration

The hostel is under the supervision of the **Hostel Superintendent**, who is responsible for the overall administration, discipline and proper functioning of the hostel.

All boarders are required to strictly follow the hostel rules and regulations and maintain **discipline, cleanliness and a healthy academic environment** within the hostel premises.
